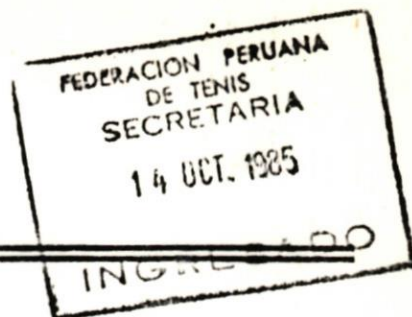

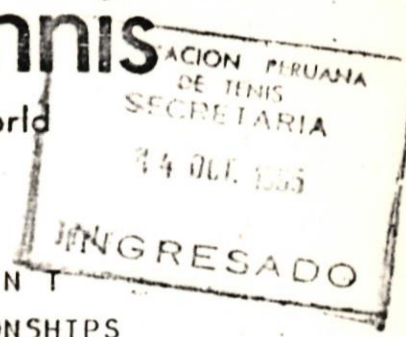

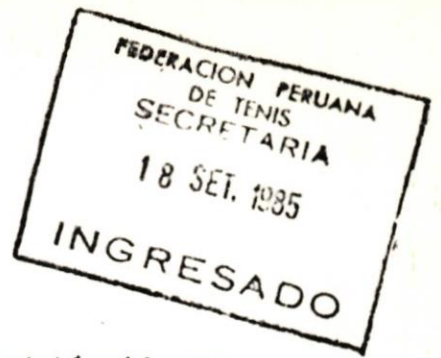

ENTRY DEADLINE:
