CONSIDERANDO :

Que, la Federación recurrente solicita al I.P.D. autorización oficial, para que su deportista Luis Felipe Del Solar Saez pueda participar en el Torneo Rolex Tournamet of - Champione, a realizarse en la ciudad de Georgia-USA, del 15 al 19 de Agosto de 1988 ;

Con las opiniones favorables de la Dirección Nacional de Deporte de Afiliados, Oficina de Asesoría Jurídica y Dirección Ejecutiva Nacional; y visto el certificado médico correspondiente ;

De conformidad con el Art.9° numeral 12 y Art.77° del Decreto Legislativo N°328- Ley General del Deporte y su Reglamento aprobado por Decreto Supremo N°07-ED-86; y con cargo a dar cuenta al Consejo Nacional del Deporte ;

SE RESUELVE :

Artículo 1° .- AUTORIZAR, a la Federación Peruana de Golf para que su deportista LUIS-FELIPE DEL SOLAR SAEZ y Sra. VERONICA SAEZ de DEL SOLAR (Delegada) viajen a la ciudad de Georgia-USA a participar en el Torneo ROLEX TOURNAMET OF CHAMPIONS , a realizarse del 15 al 19 de Agosto de 1988.

Artículo 2° .- De conformidad con el Art.77° establecido por el Decreto Legislativo N° 328 y reglamentado por el Art.76° del Decreto Supremo N°07-ED del 13-03-86, la indicada delegación deportiva está exonerada de los impuestos sobre signos de aviación a que se contrae el Decreto Legislativo N°209 sobre impuestos a los bienes y - servicios del Decreto Ley N°22317 modificado por el Art.2° del citado Decreto Legislativo N°209 y del impuesto a los viajes al exterior de los Decretos Leyes N°22317 y 24030.

Artículo 3° .- Los gastos que ocasione el indicado viaje, ascendente a la suma de TRECIENTOS SETENTISIETE MIL QUINIENTOS NOVENTISEIS INTIS con 36/100 -- - (I/.377,596.36) afectará el presupuesto de la Federación Peruana de Golf - Recursos Propios.

Artículo 4° .- La presente Resolución NO AUTORIZA la adquisición de moneda extranjera en el Mercado Unico de Cambios.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION: Players should book plane reservations into Atlanta's Hartsfield International Airport. The ROSWELL AIRPORT EXPRESS will provide shuttle service to the ROSWELL HOLIDAY INN for a fee of \$15 one way or \$25 round trip. The shuttle departs from the ground transportation area and schedule information can be obtained by calling 404-998-1893.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: You must call the golf shop at 404-992-1818 to reserve a tee time for your practice round on Monday, August 15. Practice times will begin at approximately 1:30 pm.

TOURNAMENT TEE TIMES & FORMAT: Tee times will run from 7:30 am - 9:30 am and 12:30 pm - 2:30 pm off both tees. There will be a cut after the second round for the final 36 holes. A tie for the championship will be decided by an immediate sudden death playoff.

REGISTRATION: Monday, August 15th from 11 am until 5 pm in the Horseshoe Bend Country Club Lobby. Those players unable to register at that time MUST notify the committee prior to Monday.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES: A cookout for all players will be held on Tuesday, August 16th at the Horseshoe Bend Swimming Pool. Details and tickets for parents and guests will be available at registration. All players making the final 36-hole cut are invited to the "ROLEX DINNER OF CHAMPIONS" AT 7:00 pm on Thursday, August 18th at the Horseshoe Bend Country Club Dining Room (Jackets Required).

CODE OF CONDUCT: An AJGA tournament participant shall not engage in any behavior unbecoming a golfer. Such actions include any use of drugs (including alcohol), cheating, abusive language and vandalism. Any such conduct will result in disciplinary action which could jeopardize your AJGA membership.

CADDIES/ATTIRE: Caddies are not allowed in AJGA play. Proper attire is required and failure to comply will result in disqualification (No - short shorts, tank tops, T shirts or jeans. Shirts with collar only).

GOLF CARTS: Spectator carts are not allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS!

HOUSING: If you requested private housing you will be contacted by the local committee. This is being done on a first come/first serve system based on when your application was received. The host hotel is the ROSWELL HOLIDAY INN, (404) 992-9600. They are providing a special rate of \$55.00 per night, single or double. YOU MUST CALL AND MAKE YOUR RESERVATIONS NO LATER THAN AUGUST 1ST. PLEASE IDENTIFY YOURSELF AS AN AJGA MEMBER PLAYING IN THE ROLEX TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS.

NO SHOW POLICY: If you find that you cannot compete in the ROLEX TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS, you must withdraw from the event by contacting Bobbie or Betsy at our office (404-998-4653) or by contacting tournament headquarters at the course prior to tournament registration. This allows us to replace you with an alternate. If you cannot compete and do not withdraw and are therefore a "no show", the following action will be taken.
