



## RESOLUCION No. 538-AD-89.

Lima, 20 de JULIO de 1989.

Visto el oficio N° 145 presentado por la Federación Peruana de Tiro, el cual ha motivado el expediente N° 3685.

## CONSIDERANDO:

Que, la Federación recurrente solicita autorización oficial para que el señor - JUAN GIHA ALI, viaje a la ciudad de Arhus, Dinamarca, del 22 de Julio al 06 de Agosto de 1989, a participar en los Juegos Join the Masters in 89 de Tiro;

Con las opiniones favorables de la Oficina de Asesoría Jurídica, Dirección Nacional del Deporte de Afiliados y Dirección Ejecutiva Nacional;

De conformidad con el Art. 9°-numeral 12 y Art. 77° del Decreto Legislativo N° 328 Ley General del Deporte y su Reglamento aprobado por Decreto Supremo N° 07-ED-86; y con cargo a dar cuenta al Consejo Nacional del Deporte;

## SE RESUELVE:

Artículo Primero.- Autorizar a la Federación Peruana de Tiro para que el señor - JUAN GIHA ALI, viaje a la ciudad de Arhus, Dinamarca, del 22 de Julio al 06 de Agosto de 1989, a participar en los Juegos Join the Masters in 89 de Tiro.

Artículo Segundo.- De conformidad con el Art. 77° establecido por el Decreto Legislativo N° 328 y reglamentado por el Art. 76° del Decreto Supremo N° 07-ED-86, el indicado deportista en la categoría master, está exonerado de los impuestos sobre signos de aviación a que se contrae el Decreto Legislativo N° 209, de los impuestos a los bienes y servicios del Decreto Ley N° 22317, modificado por el Art. 2° del citado Decreto Legislativo N° 209 y del impuesto a los viajes al exterior de los Decretos Leyes Nos. 22317 y 24030.

Artículo Tercero.- El costo que ocasione el indicado viaje, ascendente a la suma de DOCE MILLONES CUATROCIENTOS CINCUENTA MIL INTIS (1/. ----- (12'450,000) NO afectará al Presupuesto de la Federación Peruana de Tiro ni del Instituto Peruano del Deporte.

Artículo Cuatro.- La presente Resolución NO autoriza la adquisición de moneda extranjera en el Mercado Unico de Cambios ni en Mesa de Negociaciones.

Artículo Quinto.- Al término del citado evento internacional, la Federación Peruana de Tiro tiene quince (15) días para emitir su Informe Técnico a la Dirección Nacional del Deporte de Afiliados, el incumplimiento a esta disposición, originará que el Instituto Peruano del Deporte no de trámite al próximo pedido de autorización de viaje al extranjero.
