Vistos los Oficios Nos. RR.EE (SSPB-DGRCI-PRC) 2-8-G/144 del Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores y 429 de la Embajada del Brasil;

CONSIDERANDO :

Que en la ciudad de Brasilia se realizará el VI Congreso Brasileño de Ciencias del Deporte y el II Simposio de Informática del Deporte, organizados por el Colegio Brasileño de Ciencias del Deporte;

Que ambos eventos tendrán como tema central "Deportes y Cambios en América Latina : Contribución para la Integración";

Que dada la importancia de los eventos, es necesario acreditar la participación del país en los indicados certámenes;

De conformidad con el Decreto Legislativo 328, Ley General del Deporte y su Reglamento, aprobado mediante D.S.07-86-ED, con la opinión favorable de la Dirección Ejecutiva Nacional;

SE RESUELVE :

ART. 1° .- AUTORIZAR el viaje del señor Profesor JAVIER AGUILAR FRANCO a la ciudad de Brasilia, del 05 al 12 de setiembre de 1989 para que en representación oficial participe en el VI Congreso de Ciencias del Deporte y el II Simposio de Informática del Deporte.

ART. 2° .- De conformidad con el Art. 77° establecido por el Decreto Legislativo 328 y del Art. 76° del D.S. 07-86-ED, el viaje del citado funcionario está exonerado de los impuestos sobre Signos de Aviación a que se contrae el Decreto Legislativo N° 209 sobre impuestos de bienes y servicios del D.L. 22317, modificado por el Art. 2° del citado Decreto Legislativo N° 209 y del impuesto a los viajes al exterior de los Decretos Leyes Nos. 22317 y 24030.

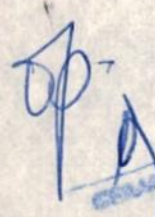

VI BRAZILIAN CONGRESS ON SPORT SCIENCES

II BRAZILIAN SYMPOSIUM OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

ON PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS

INFORMATIVE SUMMARY

On a promotion of the Brazilian School of Sport Sciences (CBCE - "Colégio Brasileiro de Ciências do Esporte") and with the technical support of RURALMÍDIA Sistemas de Comunicação, the VI Brazilian Congress on Sport Sciences and the II Brazilian Symposium of Computer Science on Physical Education and Sports will be held at the University of Brasília, 6-10 September of this year.

Both events will have as central focus the subject "Sports and Chages in Latin America: A CONtribution to the Integration", and shall bring together experts of various countries and of various fields and areas related to Human Motricity.

The VI Congress is structured in such a way as to discuss the Sport Sciences and the sport itself in the Continent in four distinct manners, divided in Groups; the Scientific Group, restricted to Sport Sciences researchers; the Technical Group, open to professionals in general and to the community; the Interchange Group, for discussion about agreements and adjustments of cooperation on areas of sport sciences and instruction; and the Ludic or Performance Group, characterized by everybody's participation and the community involvement on Sportive Practices, parallel to the Congress.

Communitary Sessions of Tai-Chi-Chuan and Capoeira, public performances of natives' daces, Asa-Delta and Ultra-Leve shows, capoeira litanies or even aerobic afternoons are some



of the events programmed to integrate the Congress' Ludic or Performance Group. For the remaining Groups, the discussions will be organized in aula magna, panels, round tables, sessions of free scientific communications and courses.

SUBJECTS:

The contents of these academic activities shall be oriented by renown professors of the scientific community, who were specially invited to ministrate the restricted and open special meetings, as well as the conversations, refering to correlated subjects, such as: History, Philosophy, Social Sciences, Administration, Pedagogy, Arts, Physical Education and Special Physical Education, Psychology, Physiology, Biomechanic, Medicine, Journalism (Communication in general), and Laws. Other areas and fields involved will be Dance, Physical Activity and Work, Physical Activity and Drug Prevention, Measurements and Evaluation, National Sports, Criativity, the Negro, the Native (Indian) and Women, exploring their relation with these Sciences and the concepts and preconceptions about these relations.

Some subjects have already been specified:

- 1- Violence in Sports - including psychological reasons, the meaning of competitiveness, the mechanisms of development of a non-violent mentality, and the meaning of sport for life;
- 2- Ecological Education - including analysis of sport and nature preservation, sport and leisure as factors of ecological sensitivity, and preservative entertaining activities;
- 3- Sport Politics and Laws - specially about constitutional devices on sport, principles to be observed when creating ordinary laws, and directrixes and basis for an action of the CBCE in legislative formalization of sports in Brazil;



- 4- Health and Physical Exercise - analysing the meaning of health in sports, the technologies for ergometric diagnosis and the doping;
- 5- Science - including issues such as scientific activities about the human motricity, bank of thesis and reports of experiences and laboratories on psico-motricity;
- 6- Turism and Sport - including sport as a pole of turistic attraction, the Summer Camp and the alternative turism.

- 1) Municipal Administration and Political-Partisan Action in the Area of Sports (City Halls of São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Belo Horizonte and Manaus);
- 2) Sport and Education: aspects (Pedagogy and Sport Education);
- 3) Physical Education and Non-Formal Sport (Clubs and Public Power);
- 4) Education, Sport and Health (and their respective politics);
- 5) Physical Education and Health Prevention;
- 6) Violence in Sport (Agressions, Dopping and Merchandising);
- 7) Motor and Ludic Aspects of Brazilian Culture (Capoeira and native dances);
- 8) The Aerobics in Mass Society.

PARALLEL EVENTS

Beside the II Brazilian Symposium of Computer Science on



Physical Education and Sports, the VI Congress will also include the First Meeting of Professionals of Aerobic Academies, for which round-tables and courses will be organized.

Another parallel event, a little unusual one, will be the seminar held in the middle of a capoeira session, where technical communications on themes like movement sequences or canticle origins are presented while the capoeira goes on.

The Embassies of the participant countries shall also, if they may, program parallel cultural events, only having to contact the Congress Organization Committee.
