Visto el Oficio N°183-FPT-89, presentado por la Federación Peruana de Tiro ;

CONSIDERANDO :

Que, la Federación recurrente solicita autorización oficial para que el señor Dr. Carlos Boza Vega León, Dirigente y Deportista, participe en el 11° Curso Nacional de Entrenadores de Tiro en el Centro de Entrenamiento Olímpico en Colorado Springs -Colorado-USA, del 06 al 09 de Octubre de 1989.

Con las opiniones favorables de la Dirección Nacional de Deporte de Afiliados, Oficina de Asesoría Jurídica y Dirección Ejecutiva Nacional; y visto el antecedente respectivo ;

De conformidad con el Art.9° numeral 12 y Art.77° del Decreto Legislativo N°328 - Ley General del Deporte y su Reglamento aprobado por Decreto Supremo N°07-ED-86; y con cargo a dar cuenta al Consejo Nacional del Deporte ;

SE RESUELVE :

Artículo 1° .- AUTORIZAR, a la Federación Peruana de Tiro para que el señor doctor CARLOS BOZA VEGA LEON, Dirigente y Deportista, viaje a la ciudad de Colorado-USA a participar en el 11° CURSO NACIONAL DE ENTRENADORES de Tiro, a realizarse en el Centro de Entrenamiento Olímpico en Colorado Springs del 06 al 09 de Octubre de 1989.

Artículo 2° .- De conformidad con el Art.77° establecido por el Decreto Legislativo N°328 y reglamentado por el Art.76° del Decreto Supremo N°07-ED-86, el indicado dirigente está exonerado de los impuestos sobre signos de aviación a que se contrae el Decreto Legislativo N°209 sobre impuestos a los bienes y servicios del Decreto Ley N°22317 modificado por el Art.2° del citado Decreto Legislativo N°209 y del impuesto a los viajes al exterior de los Decretos Leyes N°22317 y 24030.

Artículo 3° .- El costo que ocasione el indicado evento, ascendente a la suma de I/.4'600,000.00 intis, afectará el Presupuesto de la Federación Peruana de Tiro - Recursos Propios.

Artículo 4° .- La presente Resolución NO AUTORIZA la adquisición de moneda extranjera en el Mercado Unico de Cambios ni en Mesa de Negociaciones.

Artículo 5° .- Al término del citado curso, la Federación Peruana de Tiro tiene quince (15) días para emitir su Informe Técnico-Económico a la Dirección Nacional de Deporte de Afiliados, el incumplimiento a esta disposición, originará que el IPD no de trámite al próximo pedido de autorización de viaje al extranjero.

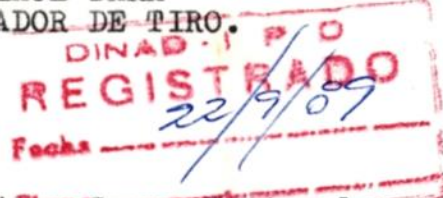

THE NRA NATIONAL SHOOTING COACHES CONFERENCE AND SPORTS RESEARCH SYMPOSIUM is a gathering of coaches to exchange ideas and receive information from experts in the fields of coaching education and shooting sports training and technology. It is also an opportunity for researchers to present projects and information.

"A Sport for Life" is the theme of the 11th annual conference, which will be held October 6-9 at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

The conference provides information to all ages and levels of coaches in a variety of disciplines. Women and coaching, developing effective communication skills, parental involvement in sport, physical fitness and range safety are just some of the issues facing today's coaches. Leading sport psychologists and medical and shooting sports experts will present current views on these and other pertinent topics. National Team coaches will lead practical sessions for rifle, pistol, trap, skeet and running target, and presentations on equipment selection, adjustment and maintenance will be given by gunsmithing professionals in each of these disciplines.

Summer biathlon fun relays will begin on Friday afternoon with bus transportation to the U.S. Air Force Ranges at Fort Carson. A modified version of summer biathlon competition, which combines running and rifle marksmanship, will be held with team relays. There is no charge to participate and everyone is encouraged to take part in this run/shoot/run version of the Winter Olympic sport. Refreshments, prizes and all equipment will be provided.

The U.S. Olympic Shooting Center and U.S. Olympic Committee conference buildings are the primary conference facilities. The shooting sports center features 50-meter pistol, rifle and running target ranges; a gunsmithing shop; shooting sports library; storage rooms and offices. The center will be the site of the welcome reception on Friday evening and the industry exhibits on Saturday and Sunday evenings. A new addition to the conference will be an auction of industry-donated shooting and sporting equipment on Sunday evening, with proceeds benefitting the International Shooter Development Fund.

Shooting truly is "a sport for life" and coaches play a vital role in its development among all age groups. The conference has become the single largest gathering of shooting sports coaches in the United States. As it continues to grow, it offers more coaches the opportunity to develop their skills and knowledge of the sport. Plan now to join fellow coaches and shooting sports professionals at the 11th NRA National Shooting Coaches Conference and Sports Research Symposium.

REGISTRATION and ACCOMMODATIONS

The conference registration fee is \$80, and attendance is limited to 200 participants. The Olympic Training Center has 170 beds available on a first-come, first-served basis. Individuals whose registrations exceed the maximum reserved bed space will be notified and assisted in locating other accommodations in Colorado Springs. Accommodations other than at the Olympic Training Center are at the participants' expense. There is a \$10 per night accommodations charge for non-U.S. citizens payable at the Olympic Training Center.

Meal tickets are \$3 each for conference participants who stay off site. If you know in advance that you will not be staying at the Olympic Training Center, please indicate the number of meal tickets needed on the registration form. Tickets can be picked up and paid for during conference registration hours.

Registration fees will only be refunded if notice of cancellation is received by September 6.

Your registration fee includes:

- NRA conference notebook and industry product samples.
- Participation in the summer biathlon fun relays.
- Friday evening welcome reception.
- Attendance at all conference sessions and exhibits.
- Drawings for shooting sports equipment and supplies.

The U.S. Olympic Training Center will provide:

- Dormitory accommodations at the Olympic Training Center from Friday check-in through Tuesday morning at 9. (Non-U.S. residents will be charged \$10 per night, payable upon arrival.)
- Meals at no charge to participants staying at the Olympic Training Center. (Those staying off site may purchase meal tickets.)
- Bus transportation between the Colorado Springs Airport and the Olympic Training Center if staying on site and **travel information accompanies registration form.**

ACADEMIC CREDIT

One semester hour of academic credit is being sought through the Department of Sport and Leisure Studies at the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs. Application forms for credit will be available during conference check-in and the cost is \$35, payable by check or major credit card.
